

Simple Light Box ~ Connie Conn of Dry Branch Primitives

This simple light box is one of my most treasured craft supplies. I used to tape my stitchery pattern to my window, but my arms and shoulders hurt something awful. Now all I have to do is place my pattern and material onto the light box, sit down in my favorite chair and trace away!

Supplies Needed:

Shallow Storage Box
Under The Cabinet Light Fixture
Extension Cord (Optional)

This is easy as 1,2,3. All you have to do is take the lid off your storage box. Place the lid, top side down on your table, counter, etc. Turn the switch of the under the cabinet light fixture to the ON position and place it in one corner of the lid. Let the cord hang out from that corner (this makes the storage box easier to close). Then place the storage box onto the lid and snap it shut. Plug the light fixture in, and you are ready to go. :) The extension cord is optional. I use it because the light fixture cord is very short and the extension cord gives me the freedom to take my light wherever I want.
